- Covered Bridges – Rt. 3 north in Lincoln pull over just before White Mountain Motel to view Clark's train Covered Bridge. Rt. 112 about 28 miles east from our Visitor's Center Albany Covered Bridge. From Rt. 16 in Conway Village take a left on West Side Rd and Saco and Swift River Covered Bridges will be on your right. Rt. 16 north heading towards Pinkham Notch, take a right on Rt. 16B to see the Honeymoon Covered Bridge in Jackson. Rt. 302 going west in

Bartlett. Covered Bridge will be on your right. Behind Littleton Main Street Littleton foot Covered Bridge. Rt. 302 in Bath behind the Brick Store is the Bath Covered Bridge.
