The Loon Center is the headquarters and education center for the Loon Preservation Committee, a 501c3 non-profit organization dedicated to protecting loons and their habitats in New Hampshire. The 200-acre Markus Wildlife Sanctuary, located along the shore of Lake Winnepesaukee, is home to many of the Lakes Region's iconic species, including loons who nest just offshore.

Monday – Saturday, Mid-May – July 1

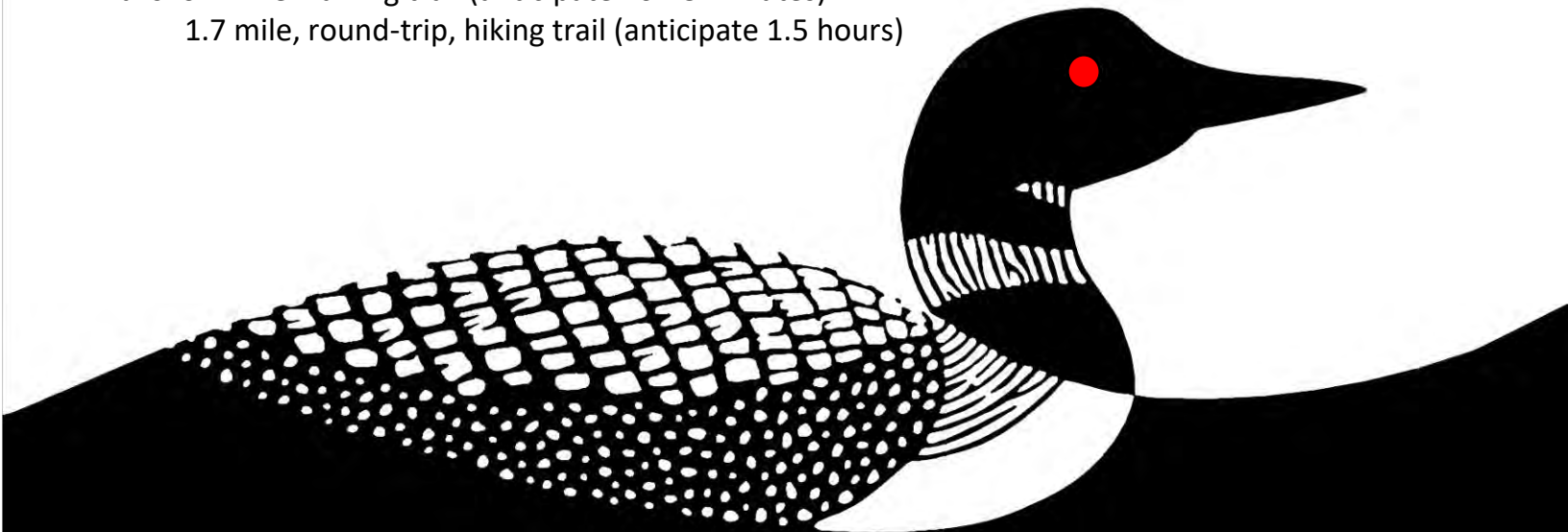
