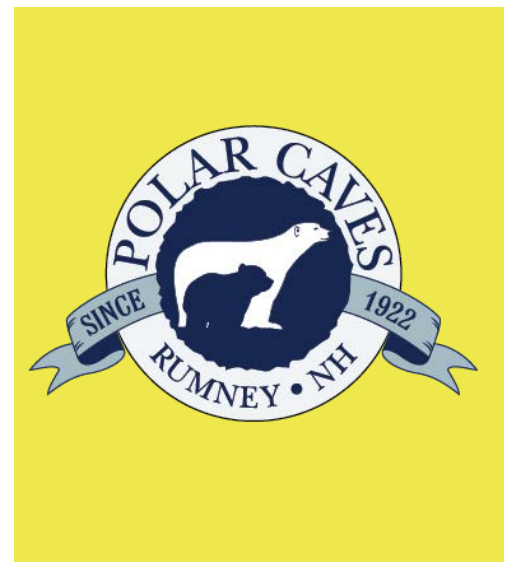

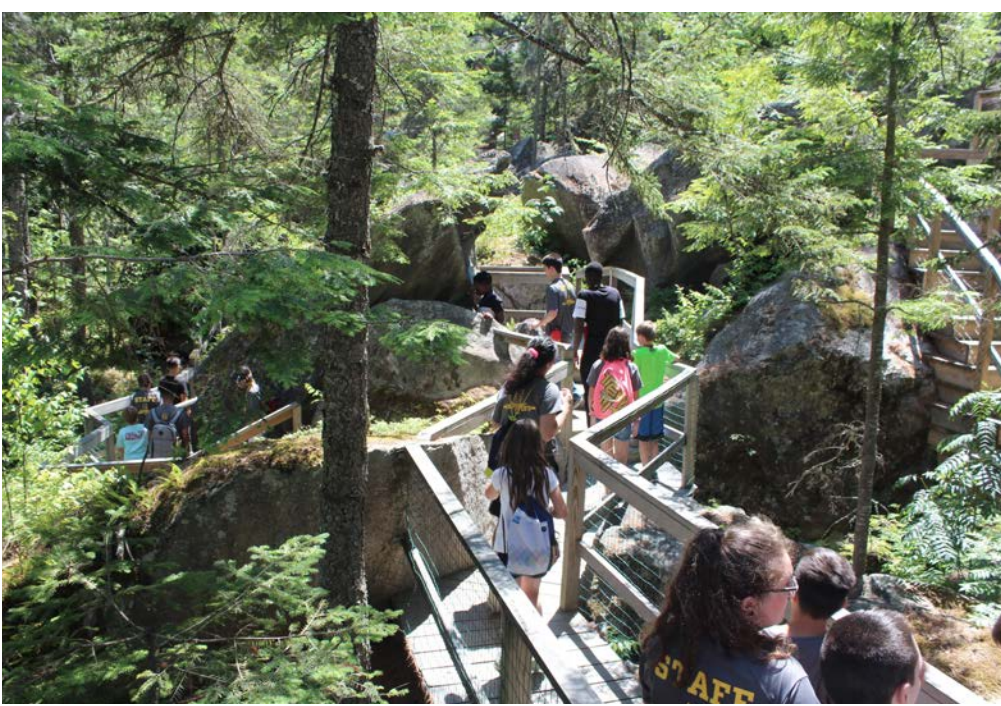
### America's Most Sensational Glacial Caves!

Fifty thousand years ago, a continental glacier moved southward over New Hampshire. As the ice sheet thawed, great blocks of granite fell from Hawk's Cliff. These massive granite blocks created a series of caves and passageways which you can come and explore. The park's name refers to the "polar" breath that emanates from the caves even on the hottest summer day!
