Our guided tours begin in mid-May and continue through mid-October. Washington Auto Road, which includes an hour on your own to explore the summit buildings and environment. ### GROUP REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for the group rate we require 25 – 45 paying guests. A \$50 deposit is required in order to secure a reservation. The Group Guide will be in charge of all payments. Arrival at the Mt. Washington Auto Road is between 9:00 and 9:30 am, and travel time to the summit is 1/2 hour. Guided tours will have 1 hour on the summit and 1/2 hour travel time back to base.
